The Pastor's Pen

What a great summer we have had at Saint Paul! We kicked off the summer with our Helping Hands ministry providing a meal for the unhoused at First Presbyterian. We started June with Vacation Bible School and the opportunity to teach 60 children just how loved they were by Jesus. And in July we all rallied together to host homeless families through A Way Home. We did all of this incredible work, while also worshipping together and spending the summer recognizing the importance of awe in our lives and in our faith. I am extremely grateful to serve a church that has a mission minded heart and a willingness to serve their community!

As fall approaches and school starts back we hope you will join us for Back to School Sunday on August 10th, and a new worship series starting on August 17th ... **The Disruptive** Grace of Jesus.

Jesus is not always comforting—sometimes, he is confrontational. His words unsettle, his actions provoke, and his invitations humble us. This series explores how Jesus challenges the status quo, dismantles false peace, heals with power and compassion, and flips the social script. As followers of Christ, we are invited not just to be comforted by his presence—but also to be changed.

What an incredible gift God has given us to be challenged, renewed, and transformed. God is constantly calling us to be people who, as Paul says in the book of Galatians have been given "love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control". These qualities are a result of the Holy Spirit working in a believer's life, demonstrating the transformation that is constantly taking place in our lives.

Which leads me to my last announcement: starting on August 28th we will return to Thursday morning bible study at 10:30am. Our first study back will be Galatians: The Glory of Grace. During this study we learn about how Jesus died to take the curse and consequence of humanity's failure into himself to bring redemption. Now, through Jesus, the offspring of Abraham, God's blessing can finally come to all people, regardless of their ethnicity, Peace,

social status, or gender.

I can't wait to kick off a new season with you!
